
- *2 : IEEE1349 Interface cannot be used for some printers. Do not connect to a printer via a repeater hub.
- *3 : When Macintosh is connected as a client PC, NIC that supports AppleTalk is needed.
- *4 : If a printer with a USB 2.0 interface is connected, the PC must have a USB 2.0 port. Do not connect the printer via a USB hub.
- *5 : Needed to use the dongle. Do not connect the dongle via a USB hub.
- *6 : It is necessary if the OS of the Raster Link Pro III-installed PC is Windows 2000 or XP and if you are using a Macintosh machine (OS: 8.6~9.2.2) as a client PC to connect to it.
- *7 : It is necessary if the OS of the Raster Link Pro III-installed PC is Windows Vista and if you are using a Macintosh machine (OS: 8.6~9.2.2) as a client PC to connect to it.

Set PC with Raster Link Pro III installed

Raster Link Pro III PC is a PC on which Raster Link Pro III is to be installed or already installed.

This is the explanation about necessary settings and the procedure of installation for operating Raster Link Pro III properly.

In this Installation Guide, the Raster Link Pro III PC host name is described as "RasterLink". Where the explanation mentions "RasterLink", substitute the host name of your Raster Link Pro III PC.




Set the Control Panel

Open the Control Panel window as follows.









Change the Host Name

Set the host name (computer name) so that the Raster Link Pro III PC can be identified on the network.

When there are several Raster Link Pro III PCs on the same network, it is necessary to change the host names to unique names so that they do not conflict.

In particular, if PC MACLAN is installed on the Raster Link Pro III PC, it is necessary to change the host name before installing Raster Link Pro III in order to perform the various PC MACLAN settings automatically.

If the OS of the Raster Link Pro III-installed PC is Windows Vista and you are using a Macintosh machine as a client PC, DAVE needs to be installed on the client PC and the host name needs to be changed so that the client PC can connect to the Raster Link Pro III PC. It is not necessary to change the host name if only one Raster Link Pro III PC is present on the network.

Raster Link Pro III makes the PC MACLAN settings automatically according to the following rules.

For example, if the host name is "RasterLink", and the Printer Name is "JV3-SP", the settings are as follows.

PC MACLAN file server settings	
File server name	: RasterLink
Shared folder name created as default	: JV3-SP
PC MACLAN print server settings	
Spooler name created as default	: JV3-SP_RasterLink

NOTE! The maximum length of the PC MACLAN print server spooler name allowed in the specification is 27 bytes. If the host name is long, spooler names longer than the limit may be cut. The same applies to the spooler name created automatically by the condition management function. Therefore, we recommend setting a short host name.

Here, the host name before being changed is "RLP", and in the following example it is changed to "RasterLink".







Set the Local Security Policy (with Windows Vista)

If you plan to install Raster Link Pro III on a PC running Windows Vista PC and use a MacOSX PC as a client PC to connect to the Raster Link Pro III PC via SMB, you need to change local security policies before installation.

If the Raster Link Pro III PC is in your domain network, you may not have to do this. For more information, contact your network administrator.

Since Windows Vista Home Premium has no local security policy feature, if you plan to use a MacOSX machine as a client PC, print using printer driver with SMB connection is not supported.

PC MACLAN installation

If the OS of the Raster Link Pro III-installed PC is Windows XP or 2000 and you are using a Macintosh machine as a client PC, PC MACLAN needs to be installed. Execute PC MACLAN installation usually before Raster Link Pro III installation.

Refer to "Installing PC MACLAN" in the PC MACLAN User's Guide for details of installation.



Installation procedure

1 Log on as an Administrator or a member of the Administrators group. The group can be checked by "User Accounts" on the "Control Panel".

2 Mount the PC MACLAN installation CD on the CD drive. The installer automatically starts.

If the installer does not start automatically, execute "setup.exe" in the CD-ROM.

Click "Install PC MACLAN," and then proceed the installation by following the indications by the installer.

Raster Link Pro III Installation

This document explains the installation procedure using Windows Vista as an example. Unless otherwise specified, use the same procedure as Windows Vista for Windows XP and Windows 2000.

(NOTE!)	 Using Mimaki's other software RIP If Raster Link Pro II is installed, Raster Link Pro III cannot be installed with- out removing the existing Pro II. Separately, the upgrade installer is neces- sary.
	If Raster Link UJ or Raster Link GP is installed, be sure to uninstall it before installing Raster Link Pro III.
	If Raster Link Pro is installed, you can install Raster Link Pro III without changes. However, Raster Link Pro cannot be used when Raster Link Pro III is running.*
	Windows Automatic Updates settings
	When Windows [Automatic Update] is set to "Automatic", the update pro- gram is installed at the set times, and it may be necessary to restart your PC. If the PC is restarted when Raster Link Pro III is running, Raster Link Pro III may not start up again properly. To prevent the PC restarting automat- ically, in the [Automatic Updates] control panel, select "Download updates for me, but let me choose when to install them".

*: Do not install any other Epson RIP software in a Windows Vista machine. As it does not support Windows Vista, it will not function normally.

Install the IEEE1394 Driver

Install the IEEE1394 driver from the device driver CD provided with the printer. For the installation method, refer to "InstallGuide(en).pdf" on the device driver CD.

Install the USB 2.0 Driver

When connecting the printer and PC with USB 2.0, install the USB 2.0 driver from the device driver CD provided with the printer.

For the installation method, refer to "InstallGuide(en).pdf" on the device driver CD.


Set the Raster Link Pro III CD

Installing Raster Link Pro III requires Administrator authority.

• Use the IEEE1394 driver Ver.2.00 or later.


Insert the installation CD-ROM of Raster Link Pro III into the CD drive, and the Raster Link Pro III installation menu starts automatically.

In case the Raster Link Pro III installation menu does not start automatically, double-click "CDMenu.exe" in the CD-ROM.



Print from Client PCs

The following explains the settings for the client PC that accesses Raster Link Pro III connected to the network. As the client PC, Windows $98SE^*/Me^*/2000/XP/V$ ista and Macintosh can be used.



*: If the OS of the Raster Link Pro III-installed PC is Windows Vista, Windows 98SE or ME, it cannot be used as the OS for a client PC.

Method for printing from client PC

Printing by using hot folder


Raster Link ProIII creates a "hot folder" for receiving image data on its installed PC. Dragging and dropping the image data onto this hot folder from a client PC enables data transfer to Raster Link Pro III. Two hot folders (four folders for JV4 series) are created when adding a printer at the "Printer Management" function, and they have respective objectives.

Folder name: "Printer Name specified at Printer Management" Hot folder for fullcolor images Folder name: "Printer Name specified at Printer Management \$m"...... Hot folder for MRL (Mimaki command file) Folder name: "Printer Name specified Printer Management \$A" Hot folder for application separation (JV4 only) Folder name: "Printer Name specified Printer Management \$R"........... Hot folder for RIP separation (JV4 only)



Printing by using printer driver

When printing directly from applications such as Adobe Illustrator and Photoshop, use the printer driver created by Raster Link Pro III. As with typical printer drivers, the printer driver created by Raster Link Pro III is specified.



(NOTE!) The output method and connection software to be used differ, depending on the combination of the operating systems of your Raster Link Pro III-installed PC and client PCs, as follows:

Uninstall Raster Link Pro III

	(NOTE !)	 All Raster Link Pro III setting is deleted when it is uninstalled. Before starting uninstalling, check the following items. * Raster Link Pro III is not running. * The Raster Link Pro III hot folder is not open (including via the network). * The Raster Link Pro III printer is not being used (including via the network). * The Raster Link Pro III hot folder and printer is not being mounted from Macintosh clients with a Macintosh network connection tool (such as PC MACLAN).
Ch	eck that	the shared folder contents are deleted

When using hot folders from Mac OS 9.x, after uninstalling Raster Link Pro III, there is possibility not to delete the installation directory.

Also when Deleting the Printer with [Printer Management], or when deleting the hot folder with [Condition Management], the message "Cannot remove file in the Hot Folder" may appear, and the process cannot be completed.

This occurs because the Macintosh client creates special folders and files in the hot folder.

To avoid this, before uninstalling Raster Link Pro III, deleting the Printer or deleting the hot folder, delete the special folders in the shared folder.


